### **Flipping Out**

Having trouble making a decision? Just flip a coin on June 1, Flip a Coin Day! The first coins were minted in ancient Lydia, an Anatolian kingdom located in present-day Turkey. They were not much more than blobs of silver or gold pressed with images of lions and lambs, but they forever transformed the way humans trade with and pay each other.

The first records of coins being tossed to make decisions date back to ancient Rome, where the practice was not called "heads or tails," but navia aut caput, or "ships and heads." One side of the coin depicted the emperor and the other the prow of a ship. One did not call out "ships" or "heads" mid-toss; instead, one person was assigned the head. If heads turned up, they won and were considered to have won the favor of the emperor. If ships turned up, they lost to their opponent. Decisions great and small have been settled by coin tosses. One notable coin toss concerned the naming of Portland, Oregon's largest city.
